Our July 6 program called Sourdough Quilts is scheduled to be presented by **Sharon Holliday**.

She's been a quilter since 1989 and has made over 400 quilts in that time. She's known for making scrap quilts and will talk about how to make fun scrappy quilts with friends in addition to presenting a trunk show of 30 plus quilts.

**Sharon Holliday** will lead a workshop on July 10 called Star Struck. In this workshop you will learn about making perfect half square triangles. If you have yearned to learn more about the Bloc-Loc rulers, this is the time! She recommends bringing the 6.5" HST ruler. If you do not have the Bloc-Loc ruler, you can use a 6" or 6.5" ruler with a diagonal line. A complete supply list will be provided when you sign up for the workshop.

The program on August 3 is going to be presented by **Trish Stuart** who will be presenting "Thread Sketching and Paint."

Her workshop on Saturday, August 7 will be "Paint on Fabric." Learn how to paint on fabric successfully. Soft, durable, permanent, clear, simple and easy method for any skill level. You will be able to select the design you want when you sign up for the workshop. I will have pictures and a sample at the July meeting.

We need 6 people minimum signed up by the July meeting to be able to have this workshop. The cost will be \$35 for the workshop and \$38 for the supplies needed. We are trying to keep the cost down and will share the Memento Luxe Stamp pads during the workshop.

























#### **Door Prize Tickets**

How do you get a door prize ticket? Let me tell you the ways.

- 1. Just for being you. Everyone who comes to the meeting gets a ticket when you sign in at the Membership table.
- 2. For bringing a show and tell. One ticket per meeting, even if you have more than one show and tell. Ask for a show and tell ticket at the Community Service table.
- 3. For turning in community service projects. Get these tickets at the Community Service table. Tickets are given out for the following:
  - 3 pillow cases = 1 ticket
  - Top that is quilted and bound = 3 tickets
  - Top only = 1 ticket
  - Quilting only = 1 ticket
  - Binding only = 1 ticket

#### Sack Lunch Ministry

The demand for the church's sack lunches has grown tremendously, with the church now giving away about 35 lunches a week to the homeless or the hungry. The following is the list of items for the sack lunch ministry operated by our facility location host, First Presbyterian Church. Just pack the lunches in a small brown paper sack with non-perishable items, such as:

- canned tuna or chicken salad
- peanut butter and crackers
- cheese and crackers
- chips
- fruit cup
- cookies
- pudding



You may also include a drink (although not necessary) as well as a napkin and spoon. Items should not require a can opener. <u>Bottled water is also much appreciated.</u> You can find many of these items at a Dollar Tree, Big Lots, Wal-Mart, etc.

The church also collects pancake mix and syrup. We also have a tip jar at the sign-in table, and if everyone were to throw in their loose change we could donate a great deal to the church each month. Thank you so much!










This is a quilt she started so long ago and has forgotten who the designer is. Quilted by Kim proctor.
